
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Richard Lange I represented by Peter Dealbert



Richard Lange is a critically acclaimed author and screenwriter who writes crime stories that are thrilling, funny and redemptive. His writing has been compared to both Elmore Leonard and Charles Bukowski. Lange's novel, Angel Baby, sold competitively to Warner Brothers with Lange attached to adapt the screenplay. He was awarded The Hammett Prize for Angel Baby, a distinction in literary crime fiction. Lange is the author of the novel, The Smack, This Wicked World and the short story collections, Sweet Nothing and Dead Boys. His new, upcoming novel entitled Rovers will be published Summer 2021. Lange's short stories have appeared in The Sun, The Iowa Review and Best American Mystery Stories, and as part of the Atlantic Monthly's Fiction for Kindle series. Lange's other accolades include: the 2008 recipient of the Rosenthal Family Foundation Award for Literature from the American Academy of Arts and Letters; a finalist for the William Saroyan International Prize for Writing; the 2015 Short Story Dagger from Great Britain's Crime Writers' Association for his short story Apocrypha; and was awarded a Guggenheim Fellowship in 2009.
